HOUSING

Residential participants stay in air-conditioned suites in *Great Plains West* located on South Washington Street between the blocks of 14th AVE SW and 15th AVE SW. Parking is free during the summer. The price per single room is \$25 and a double room is \$22 plus tax at 8.5%. Each room has twin beds with a common area and bath unit in each suite. Bed and bath linens are not provided. Housing registration is from 6-8pm on Sunday. Rooms are available Sunday through Thursday night.
