LOCATION

Classes are held at Northern State University 1200 South Jay Street, Aberdeen South Dakota. Workshops will be in held in Dacotah Hall, Johnson Fine Arts Center, Lincoln Hall and Spafford Hall on campus. Parking on campus is free and available at the Student Center, Barnett Center and the Johnson Fine Arts Center.

HOUSING

Residential participants stay in air-conditioned suites in *Great Plains West* located on South Washington Street between the blocks of 14th AVE SW and 15th AVE SW. Parking is free during the summer. The price per single room is \$25 and a double room is \$22 plus tax at 9%. Each room has twin beds with a common area and bath unit in each suite. Bed and bath linens are not provided. Housing registration is from 6-8pm on Sunday. Rooms are available Sunday through Thursday night. To check out please leave your room key and card on the desk in the room and the staff will pick them up. There is a \$25 fee if the key is not returned.
