GRANT FUNDING FOR JULY 1, 2021 - JUNE 30 2022

INDIVIDUAL ARTISTS

ALL ARTISTS

Artist Career Development Grant
\$2,000 grant provides financial support for any artist committed to advancing their work and careers as artists. Funds to assist in producing works, marketing or promotion, or reaching new audiences for existing work. Artists with limited publication, performance, or exhibitions should apply.

ESTABLISHED ARTISTS

Artist Fellowship Grant
\$5,000 grant rewards individual artistic excellence. Designed to recognize exceptional artists; encourage creative achievement; acknowledge artists who contribute to higher standards for the arts; and assist artists in their continued development. Artists with limited publication, performance, or exhibitions should apply for an *Artist Career Development Grant*.

ARTIST PROJECTS

Project Grant
Up to \$2,000, matched dollar for dollar, to assist in presenting an arts activity or project that serves the general public.



COLLABORATING ARTISTS

COLLABORATION

Artist Collaboration Grant
Up to \$6,000 grant designed to expand the horizon and artistic base of South Dakota artists through collaboration. Funding to assist in producing new work, artistic collaboration, or reaching new audiences. Collaborations may pair artists working in the same or different disciplines.

TRADITIONAL ARTISTS

Traditional Art Apprenticeship Grant
\$4,000 grant encourages the continuation of traditional arts and cultures. The grant provides financial support for master artists committed to teaching their traditional art form or for artists looking to learn more about their art from a master.

ANNUAL GRANT FUNDING

ARTS PROJECTS

Project Grant

Provides no more than 50% of costs and up to \$5,000 for presenting an arts activity that serves the general public. Project Grants must be matched at least dollar for dollar. Recipients of Arts Challenge Grants or Importation of Musicians Grants are not eligible to apply.

SOUTH DAKOTA ORCHESTRAS

Importation of Musicians Grant

Provides no more than 50% of costs and up to \$5,000 to orchestras that need to import musicians (unavailable within the home community) to improve the quality of a performance season. Grants must be matched at least dollar for dollar.



Grants for 501 c 3 nonprofit organizations and units of government physically located in South Dakota.

INTERIM GRANT FUNDING

Throughout the year nonprofit groups can apply for interim funds:

Technical Assistance Grant

Provides matching funds up to \$500 for specialists to advise groups on technical matters, specific programs, projects, and/or administrative functions when this know-how is not available within the organization.

Professional Development Grants

Provides matching funds of up to \$500 to assist individuals associated with the arts to access opportunities that improve their abilities and their organization.

Excursion Grant

Up to \$500 in matching funds to assist in transporting K-12 students and persons with disabilities to arts events in other communities.
