Writing is one of the things that sets JJ free from his disabilities and allows him to escape. In addition to writing, he has always been interested in the office of the President of the United States because his grandmother, Ellen Janis, worked on JFK's campaign to feed people. Following in her footsteps, he recently became one of the newest members of the A-Team Black Hills, which advocates for the rights of the disabled. In his spare time he leads an Elvis fan club.
