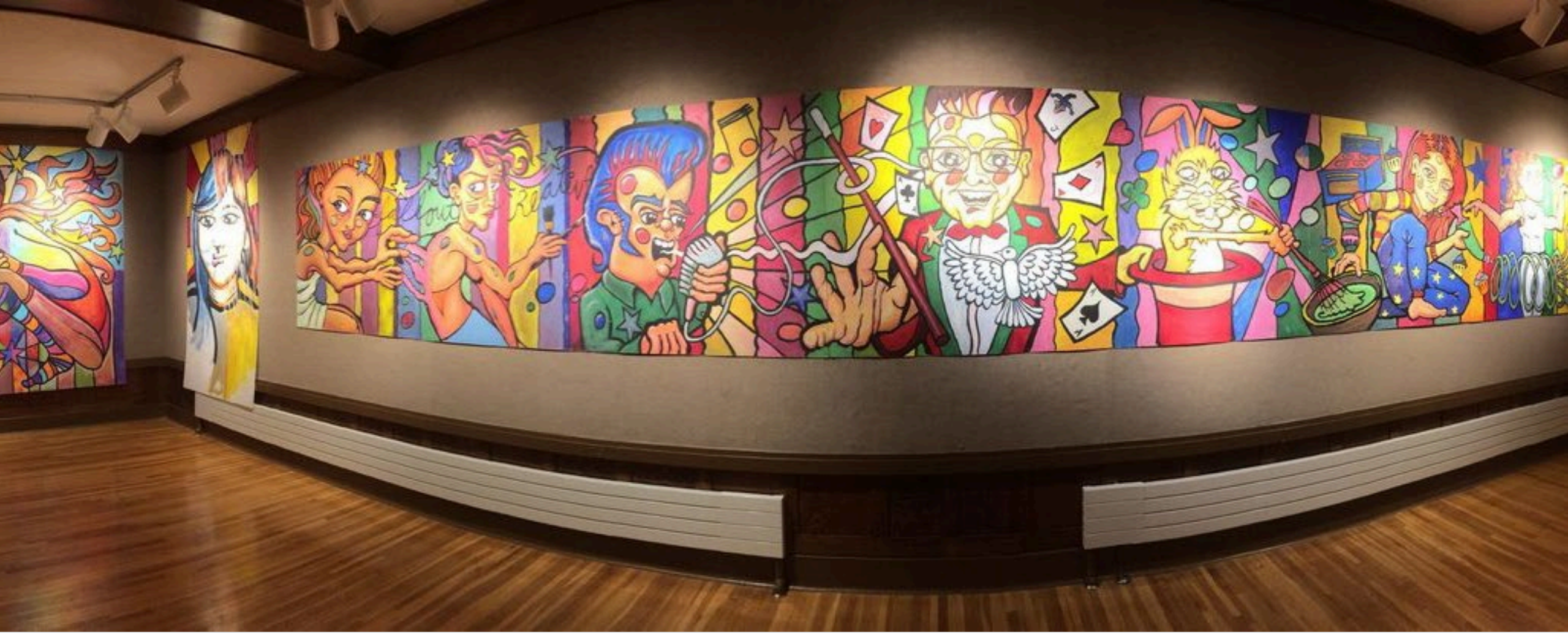

OPPORTUNITIES

Grants available for artists and arts organizations

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES:

We fund activities in the following arts disciplines: dance, music, opera/music theater, theater, visual arts, design arts, crafts, photography, media arts, literature, interdisciplinary arts, folk arts, humanities, multidisciplinary arts, or any combination of the above.

Applicants that **do not** meet the eligibility requirements **will not be reviewed**. Contact the staff with any questions regarding eligibility.

GRANTS TO ARTISTS

ARTS FELLOWSHIP – Dalton Coffey (2022)

GRANTS

Artist Career Development Grants support anyone committed to advancing their artistic work and career.

Artist Fellowships reward artists for their exceptional talent and past artistic achievement.

Artist Collaboration Grants support **two artists** working together to advance their work and careers.

Traditional Arts Apprenticeship Grants support master artists committed to teaching South Dakota's traditional arts and cultures to qualified apprentices.

Artist Project Grants support opportunities for public engagement with, and access to the arts.

Artists cannot apply in more than one grant category.

APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2023 (11:59 PM CST)



ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBLE ARTISTS:

Artist Grants support any South Dakota-based individual committed to advancing their artistic work and career.

Applicant **must reside** in South Dakota or within the borders of the state's nine federally recognized Tribal reservations for **at least one year** prior to the start of the grant (**July 1, 2023**) and remain a resident through the end of the grant (**June 30, 2024**).

Artist Fellowship applicants **must reside** in the state for **at least two years** prior to application (**March 1, 2023**) and remain a resident through the end of the grant (**June 30, 2024**).

RESTRICTIONS

SDAC **WILL NOT** GRANT TO:

anyone pursuing a high school diploma, or a graduate, undergraduate, or professional degree.
individuals and organizations seeking funds for the same project.

SDAC **WILL NOT** GRANT FOR:

activities, events, programs, or projects that fall outside of the grant period (**July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024**).
activities that occur during a religious service.
academic research, formal study, tuition assistance, scholarships, or any activities when the primary purpose is to generate academic credit or towards academic or professional degrees.

GRANTS TO ORGANIZATIONS

PROJECT GRANT – Vermillion Area Arts Council

ELIGIBILITY

South Dakota-based

Nonprofit, tax-exempt organizations

Units of state or local government

Federally recognized tribal governments

ALL ORGANIZATIONS must have a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) from the System for Award Management (SAM) to apply. The UEI is a 12-character alphanumeric ID assigned to an entity by SAM.gov. [<https://sam.gov/content/duns-uei>]

APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2023 (11:59 PM CST)



DEFINITIONS

South Dakota-based – Organizations must be physically located in the state of South Dakota or within the borders of the state’s nine federally recognized Tribal reservations and be registered, in good standing, with the South Dakota Secretary of State’s Office.

Nonprofit, tax exempt – Organizations must have tax-exempt status under section **501(c)(3)** of the Internal Revenue Code.

RESTRICTIONS

SDAC **WILL NOT** GRANT TO:

fiscal agents for regranting to or on behalf of organizations that do not have nonprofit, tax-exempt status.

religious organizations engaged in arts projects/activities that are religious, occur during a religious service, and/or benefit a limited audience/community.

individuals and organizations seeking funds for the same project.

APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2023 (11:59 PM CST)



PROJECT GRANTS

Support opportunities for public engagement with, and access to the arts. Artists/Organizations may request up to 50% of projected expenses.

Organizations can request a maximum of \$5000.

RESTRICTIONS

SDAC **WILL NOT** GRANT FOR:

activities, events, programs, or projects that fall outside of the grant period (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024).

construction (new or permanent structural change), renovation, or restoration.

endowment funds.

emergency relief funds for housing, food, etc. to individuals/artists.

costs of goods for resale, including concessions, promotional merchandise, or any items purchased for sale, even if related to your programming.

awards to individuals or organizations to honor or recognize achievement.

any recognition award to an individual, including any level of prize money.

APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2023 (11:59 PM CST)



RESTRICTIONS

SDAC **WILL NOT** GRANT FOR:

activities/projects that exclude the public, including performances and workshops which are only available through a subscription, season tickets, or membership.

receptions, parties, galas, meals, community gatherings, social activities etc., and any associated costs including food, catering, alcoholic beverages, as well as costs for the planning, staffing, and supplies, for such activities.

fundraising activities or events, and any associated salaries or other costs for any fundraising activities, including those for donors, or that benefit the organization.

GRANT REVIEW

PROJECT GRANT – Native POP

GRANT REVIEW

Grant review panels evaluate applications and assign points based on the artistic merit and artistic excellence of each proposal.

Refer to the [GRANT GUIDELINES](#) for scoring criteria.

Panels consists of in-state and out-of-state professionals, with arts knowledge and experience, and are facilitated by an Arts Council Board and SDAC staff member. Service on panels is limited to two years.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

DEADLINE: March 1, 2023, at 11:59 pm Central.

Late applications will not be accepted.

DRAFT REVIEW

SDAC will review a draft proposal and provide feedback; we request that applicants submit their draft two weeks prior to the submission deadline.

DRAFT REVIEW DEADLINE: February 14, 2023, at 11:59 pm Central.

Staff review the grant narrative, budget, and support materials for compliance and consistency

Help applicants improve their applications by checking for mistakes or omissions that might cause ineligibility

Staff do not provide grammatical editing or rewriting services

Staff provide feedback to the applicant with time for corrections ahead of the grant deadline

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Grant funding is competitive.

Keep the review criteria in mind.

Follow the instructions and application guidance carefully. Contact staff if you need assistance.

All sections of the application are required. Answer every question. Attach the maximum number of samples/support materials.

Be concise and clear. Establish your major points and avoid unnecessary complexity. Provide accurate and consistent information.

Keep the audience in mind. Do not assume that reviewers are familiar with you/your organization.

Proofread the application. Avoid misspellings and grammatical errors. Pass your application on to someone else for review, an unbiased third-party reader is BEST.

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Artists in Schools & Communities Residency Program

Applications for residencies occurring between July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024, are being accepted through March 10, 2023.

Residency activities must be a minimum of one week in length and include 20 teaching hours.

Applicants may apply for as many weeks as they'd like to host an artist.

Residency weeks may be held consecutively or spaced out throughout a year.

Apply to participate as an Arts Council Roster Artist

- review and score application materials
- comment on their quality and merit
- participate in the panel discussion

Panels represent a broad range of artistic and cultural viewpoints. Panelists may be experienced in a specific art form or be a person that is knowledgeable about the arts but not engaged in the arts as a profession.

FAQ

I am working towards my diploma/degree, can I apply?

NO. We cannot grant to anyone pursuing a high school diploma, or a graduate, undergraduate, or professional degree.

NO. We do not grant for academic research, formal study, tuition assistance, scholarships, or any activities **when the primary purpose** is to generate academic credit or towards academic or professional degrees.

How do I know which Artist Grant to apply for?

REFER TO THE CHEAT SHEET. We prefer artists make this decision for themselves based on the information we provide.

APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2023 (11:59 PM CST)



FAQ

Can we apply to improve/renovate/purchase a building, vehicle, permanent structure?

NO. The Arts Council cannot fund capital assets/improvements, new building construction, or endowment funds.

You **CAN APPLY FOR** supplies, equipment, staff, etc. related to your work.

Can we apply for funding to buy promotional merchandise or food to be sold at events?

NO. We cannot provide funding for any costs of goods for resale, especially not food/beverage/alcohol.

Can we apply on behalf of another organization?

NO. We do not grant to **fiscal agents** for regranting to or on behalf of organizations that do not have nonprofit, tax-exempt status.

OFTEN applicants will accidentally start multiple applications. You will only use **START** when you begin your application.

After you **START** an application, go back and **EDIT** the application (IN PROGRESS) each time. **DO NOT** start a new application every time you return to the system.

FAQ

We host an annual art show and want to award prize money, can we apply?

NO. We do not provide funds for awards to individuals or organizations to honor or recognize achievement, including any recognition award to an individual, including any level of prize money.

WE CAN FUND space rental, marketing, jurors, etc. for the event, BUT NOT awards to individuals. *Applying for **eligible expenses** frees up applicants to pay for **ineligible expenses** with their own money.*

FAQ

When will I find out if I got funding?

We do our best to notify grantees as soon as we are able.

Recently, award notifications were sent by **email** the third full week of June. We work very hard to notify applicants ahead of July 1 and strive for that this year as well.

FAQ

We want to host a gala/reception/social/donor function, can we apply?

NO. We do not provide funding for receptions, parties, galas, meals, community gatherings, socials, fundraising activities, or events. We do not pay for food, catering, alcoholic beverages, as well as costs for the planning, staffing, and supplies, for such activities.

WE CAN FUND an artist to perform at receptions, parties, galas, meals, community gatherings, socials, fundraising activities, or events; but not the party itself.
