Artists will be notified of exhibit acceptance on or before July 7, 2023.

June 30th, 2023: The application window closes at midnight. June 30th - July 7th, 2023: Selection process will take place by The Center for Western Studies Art Committee. July 7th, 2023: Notification of accepted work July 7th- July 22nd, 2023: Accepted work(s) needs to be dropped off or delivered to 2121 S. Summit Ave, Sioux Falls, SD 57105. Artist responsible for shipping costs. July 24th, 2023: Exhibition Opened TBD - Artists Reception October 20th, 2023: Exhibition Closes October 23rd: Artists Pick-up Art works.

#### ELIGIBILITY

All work must be original, unsold work, and the artist must own the sole copyright to art. Frames, mats and wiring must be professional quality and in good condition. No saw-tooth hangers. Wiring must be securely fashioned and support the weight of the artwork. 2D artwork selected for exhibition MUST BE READY TO HANG. Shipping and Delivery: Accepted work may be hand delivered or shipped prepaid to arrive no later than July 22nd, 2023. Artists are also responsible for return shipping costs.

#### **FEES & SALES**

Accepted art will be displayed as submitted and artists have the option of selling their work. Please include price when submitting art for sale. All exhibit sales will be handled through the CWS gift shop, and a **30%** commission will be collected from the sale price by CWS for all pieces sold as a result of the exhibition. Please price artwork with that commission deduction in mind. All scheduling, freight cots, and delivery/pick-up charges will be the responsibility of the artist.
